Who We Become: Part 1

**One of a trio of short plays by acclaimed American playwright Lanford Wilson**

New York based live performance and film production company **Deep Flight Productions** makes its UK debut at this year's **Edinburgh Festival Fringe** with three one-act plays by **Pulitzer prize-winning playwright Lanford Wilson**, under the umbrella title **Who We Become**.

Who We Become: Part 1 consists of **The Moonshot Tape**, performed by **Margaret Curry**, who is reprising the role from its 2024 Off-Broadway run. Diane, a successful writer, has returned to her hometown to assist her aging mother. As she responds to the questions of an unseen local journalist, Diane embarks on a cataclysmic verbal journey, unravelling inward, chaotic and exhilarating truths. Written with typical Wilson poetic storytelling and raw emotion, it explores the flashpoints in life where choices are made and destinies are altered, asking, "What would you do for revenge?"

Deep Flight Productions was formed to 'explore and ask questions around things that society tends to deem as taboo, inconvenient or "hard to look at", to bring the elephants in the rooms out of the shadows and into the light.' This mission makes it a perfect fit for **Wilson's** work, a writer who, as his *Los Angeles Times* obituary says, 'revealed his heart through rich and emotional dramas'.

Fuelled by the powerful audience response to its 2024 Off-Broadway run at the Flea, **Deep Flight Productions** brings **Who We Become: Parts 1 & 2** to the Edinburgh Festival Fringe, once again under the direction **Mark Cirnigliaro** with **Toni Bashinelli** serving as consulting producer.
